Jay D. Keener, MD is a professor of Orthopedic Surgery at Washington University in St. Louis. He is the Chief and Fellowship Director of the Shoulder and Elbow Reconstruction Service.

Dr. Keener originally trained as a physical therapist and has been a faculty member of the Department of Orthopaedic Surgery at Washington University since 2006. In 2011 he completed the ASES European Travelling Exchange Fellowship.

Dr. Keener has an interest in clinical based research focusing on the Natural History of rotator cuff disease, outcomes of cuff repair and shoulder arthroplasty surgery. Dr. Keener has received R01 level funding from the NIH to study the natural history of degenerative rotator cuff tears for the past 15 years. In 2014, he was awarded the Kappa Delta Ann Doner Award for his research in rotator cuff disease.

Currently, Dr. Keener is an active member of the American Society of Shoulder and Elbow Surgery serving on several committees and the American Orthopedic Association. He is a founder and co-chair of the recurring ASAP (Advanced Shoulder Arthroplasty) meeting. He has received several awards within the Orthopedic Department for excellence in patient care and resident education including the Lee T Ford and Jerome Gilden Awards. He is actively involved at a national level in education pertaining to all aspects of shoulder and elbow disorders.
