Michael T. Archdeacon, MD, MSE joined the Department of Orthopaedic Surgery at the University of Cincinnati in 2001. He was the Vice-Chair of Orthopaedic Surgery from 2006 until 2013 when he was appointed the Peter J. Stern Professor and Chairman of the Department of Orthopaedic Surgery. He served as the Chief of Staff for the University of Cincinnati Medical Center from 2008 – 2012 and as the Medical Director of Operative Services for UC Health from 2011 – 2020. In 2021, Dr. Archdeacon was elected as CEO of UC Physicians and appointed as the Senior Associate Dean of Clinical Affairs for the UC College of Medicine.

Dr. Archdeacon attended Tulane University School of Engineering and obtained his Bachelor of Science degree in Biomedical Engineering. He then attended The Ohio State University College of Medicine where he received his MD and simultaneously obtained a Master of Science in Engineering. He completed his Orthopaedic residency training at Case Western Reserve where he also participated in a one-year Allen Orthopaedic Surgical Research Fellowship at the Case Western Reserve School of Medicine. He furthered his training with a fellowship in Orthopaedic Traumatology at Tampa General Hospital under the direction of Roy Sanders, MD. He is board-certified by the American Board of Orthopaedic Surgery specializing in difficult fracture care and fractures of the pelvis and acetabulum. Dr. Archdeacon has published more than 100 peer-reviewed articles and has been invited as a visiting professor both nationally and internationally at thirty-six institutions. He has been named a “Best Doctor in America” by Cincy Magazine and a “Top Doc” in Cincinnati magazine for 15 consecutive years.

Dr. Archdeacon is the Immediate Past President of the Orthopaedic Trauma Association and the Past President of the Ohio Orthopaedic Society. He is also a member of the American Academy of Orthopaedic Surgeons Board of Councilors and State Orthopaedic Societies Committee.
